Approval of Minutes:

Executive Session Meeting of 6 June 2017

Mr. Chapman asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the regularly scheduled meeting of 6 June 2017. Mr. Spillers made the motion to approve. Mr. Braswell seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Public Hearing:

Ms. Luisa Campbell appeared before the board requesting approval for a beer and wine license for her convenience store located at 728 Aldridge Road. After questions and discussion Mr. Thomas asked that it be tabled until the next meeting. After further discussion Mr. Thomas withdrew his motion to table. Mr. Braswell made a motion to approve. Seconded by Mr. Blasingame. Motion carried 3-2.

Appearances:

Ms. Margaret Kenworthy and Mr. Ken Smith appeared before the board ref concern that if the dam on her pond broke or had a catastrophic failure the culvert pipe under Hopewell Road would not be able to funnel the water without it washing out the road. Mr. Smith presented photos to the board. After much discussion it was determined that the Maintenance Dept would inspect the pipe and possibly fix the outflow end.

Announcements:

CM informed the BOC the Rec Dept lights had been completed. 100k with a county match of 50k. Audit was complete and presented audit report booklets. 2018 LMIG submissions were needed for the next meeting. Scrap tire amnesty would be 30 June – 14 July. Showed photos of new flooring at the jail.

Old Business:

After discussing the proposals Mr. Braswell made a motion to accept BTBB Inc to proceed with the CGTC project. Mr. Blasingame seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Mr. Spillers abstained.

Road Pavings:

Overlays on Causey Road:


CM asked the BOC to approve a change order request for Womack Paving to patch two spots on Causey Road totaling \$4,476.00. Mr. Spillers made a motion to approve. Mr. Thomas seconded. Motion carried 5-0

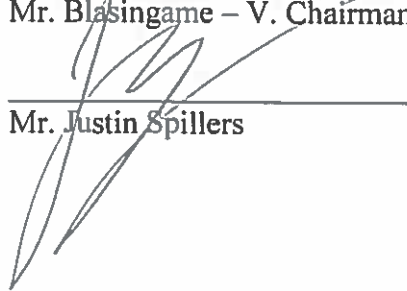
Adjourn:

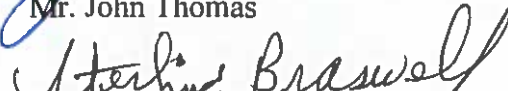

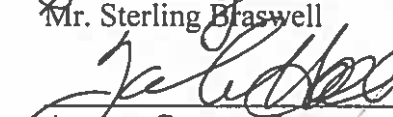
