2018 LMIG Road List:

After discussion reference new paving standards Mr. Braswell made a motion to approve the 2018 LMIG road list. Mr. Spillers seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Regional Transportation Tax Road List:

Mr. Chapman and Mr. Dickey (State Representative) gave an overview of the Regional Transportation Tax if the voters approve and the benefits to the county. Our number one priority was passing lanes on US 80. Additionally, after much discussion it was determined that each commissioner would send the County Manager a list of roads in their district totaling 6 miles for inclusion as additional projects.

New Business:

Development Authority Board Member Reductions:

After much discussion a motion was made by Mr. Braswell and seconded by Mr. Thomas that the board be reduced to a 7 member board with the inclusion of the Mayor and Chairman being voting members. Excess members would be removed by attrition or resignation pending legal opinion from the County Attorney with respect to number of meetings attended. Motion carried 4-0

Development Authority Member Appointments:

Three current board members were up for re-appointment since their terms expire in November. Mr. Charlie Westberry, Mrs. Brenda Carroll and Mr. Arthur Bentley. All three stated they were willing to serve another term. Mr. Braswell made a motion to re-appoint all three. Mr. Thomas seconded. Motion carried 4-0

Executive Session:

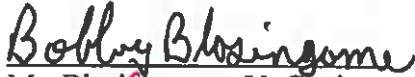
Adjourn:

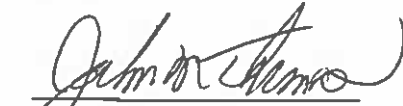

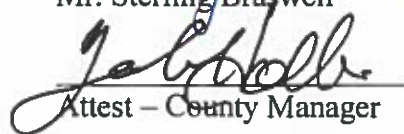
