County Manager presented the E-911 resolutions to the BOC. Mr. Thomas made the motion to approve. Mr. Braswell seconded. Motion carried 4-0

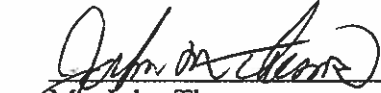
